Create Salesforce and Jira assignment groups in ServiceNow (multi-app integration)



To specify which app you want to share your ServiceNow data to in a multi-app ServiceBond integration, you can trigger sharing to the appropriate app by choosing an assignment group for each of your ServiceNow dynamic shares. As **Salesforce** and **Jira** are not default assignment groups in a ServiceNow instance, you will need to add these groups to your instance's **Groups** (sys_user_groups) table.

Procedure

To create Salesforce and Jira assignment groups in ServiceNow for your multi-app ServiceBond integration, follow these steps:



Access the Groups table

Log into your ServiceNow instance and navigate to System Security > Users and Groups > Groups.



Create new assignment groups

Create two new assignment groups with Names of Salesforce and Jira by clicking New and then Submit to save each group.
