Procedure

To view the domain and scope for dynamic share [business rules](#), follow these steps:

Log into your domain-separated ServiceNow instance and navigate to **Perspectium > Replicator > Dynamic Share**.

Click the **Business Rule** tab. The domain for your dynamic share's business rules will be displayed in the **Domain** field.
